

ORDINANCE NO. 160-16

AN AMENDMENT TO THE APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF UNION CITY, TENNESSEE, FOR FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2015 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2016

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNION CITY, THAT:

SECTION 1: The following appropriations for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2015 and ending June 30, 2016, be and the same are hereby amended by the City Council for the City of Union City, Tennessee, by

Adding:

<i>School System General Purpose Expense \$283,786.76</i>

<i>Total School System</i>	<i>\$260,725.55</i>

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3:



SECTION 4: The provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any of its sections, provisions, exceptions, sentences, clauses, phrases, or parts shall be held unconstitutional or void, the remainder of this ordinance shall continue in full force and effect, it being the intent now hereby declared that this ordinance would have been adopted even if such unconstitutional or void matter had not been included therein.

SECTION 5: This ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days from and after its passage on second and final reading and after publication in the official city newspaper.
