

ORDINANCE NO 163-16

AN APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF UNION CITY, TENNESSEE, FOR FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2016 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2017.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UNION CITY, THAT:

SECTION 1. The following appropriations for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2016, and ending June 30, 2017, be and the same are hereby made for the operation of the several departments of the City of Union City, Tennessee, by funds as follows:

SECTION 2. Such salaries as the Council is required to fix by Ordinance are hereby fixed as set forth in the detailed budget estimate for the respective department.


SECTION 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.


SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall take effect 10 days from and after its passage on second and final reading and after publication in the Official City newspaper.


