

ORDINANCE NO. 173-17

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF UNION CITY, TENNESSEE,
AMENDING TITLE 8, CHAPTER 1 AND 2, OF THE UNION CITY MUNICIPAL CODE
BEER ALCOHOL CONTENT

WHEREAS, the State of Tennessee has changed the definition of beer to be of alcohol content of not more than eight (8%) percent by weight; and

WHEREAS, the City of Union City seeks to amend its Municipal Code to comply with state statutes; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Union City, Tennessee:

Section 1. Section 8-101 of the Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

Intoxicating liquor shall be defined to include whiskey, wine, "home brew", "moonshine", and all other intoxicating spirituous, vinous, or malt liquors and beers which contain more than eight percent (8%) percent of alcohol by weight.


Section 2. Section 8-206(9) of the Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:


That the applicant will not allow any alcoholic beverage having an alcohol content of more than .08 (8%) by weight to be possessed, sold or consumed on the premises.

Section 3: This ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days from and after its passage on second and final reading and after publication in the official City Newspaper.
